

HAMPTON FC CODE OF CONDUCT - PARENTS

Hampton FC is very proud to offer inclusive football opportunities for junior footballers of ALL ages and abilities.

Our Coaches and parents play an important part in ensuring Hampton FC players enjoy their football and are able to develop in a safe environment.

Whilst my son/daughter is attending Hampton FC Training/Matches I will:

1. Remember that children play for FUN and develop at their own pace.
2. Applaud effort, good play and success - for Hampton FC AND opposition teams.
3. Respect Referee (and Linesman) decisions - even when I don't agree with them.
4. Remain behind the Respect Barrier and within the Designated Spectator Area.
5. Let the Hampton FC Coach do their job and not confuse players by shouting instructions.
6. Encourage players to respect team mates, the opposition and match officials.
7. Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive/ insulting /abusive language or behaviour.
8. Ensure monthly subs are paid on time.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code of Conduct the following action may be taken by Hampton FC:

- First Offence - issued with a verbal warning by a Club or League Official.
- Second Offence - required to attend a meeting with the Club, League or Welfare Officer.
- Third Offence - suspension from Hampton FC Training and/or Matches.
- Continued Offending - exited from Hampton FC (together with any dependents)

Monthly subs are essential to fund Hampton FC Teams.

I understand that if subs are not paid then any/all of the following actions may be taken by Hampton FC:

1. A 7 day reminder and warning issued by the Club Treasurer.
2. Player suspended from Training and Matches.
3. Exit from Hampton FC.
